Introduction

Participation points are not awarded for the Meals from the Heartland Challenge, however, the company logging the most volunteers to pack meals will be presented with the “Corridor Corporate Games Meals from the Heartland Challenge” award. Meals from the Heartland will administer the Challenge.

General Guidelines

1. Send volunteers to help at the Meals from the Heartland Cedar Rapids Hunger Fight event at the Doubletree by Hilton Cedar Rapids Convention Complex.
 - a. Register your volunteers beginning May 4 at <https://mealsfromtheheartland.org/event/cedar-rapids-hunger-fight/>
 - b. Meals from the Heartland will keep a tally of each volunteer shift.
 - c. Packaging shifts run for approximately two hours and will be offered on the following dates and time frame:
 - Thursday, June 10**
1:00pm - 3:00pm
 - Friday, June 11**
9:00am - 11:00am | 1:00pm - 2:45pm | 3:00pm - 4:45pm | 6:00pm - 8:00pm | 6:30pm - 8:30pm
 - Saturday, June 12**
9:00am - 11:00am
2. Host/ Sponsor a “Mobile Meal Packaging Event” with Meals from the Heartland at your company location. Funding is required at \$0.20 per meal for Mobile Meal Packaging Events. This is a great way to increase participation, maximize your impact, and minimize downtime.

Participants must register with your company in order to be counted. At the end of the challenge, whichever company from each division has the most volunteers wins the “Corridor Corporate Games Meals from the Heartland Challenge” award. The winning companies in each division will receive an award.
